## Adult In-House Policies

### Start Date:

A League : March 4<sup>th</sup>2012 B League : March 4<sup>th</sup> 2012 C League : March 4<sup>th</sup> 2012

### Payments:

For Sponsored Teams:

### The Team Captain is responsible for collection of payments:

- 1) \$4800.00 (excluding USA Hockey). Team roster MUST include jersey numbers by first game.
- 2) Team Sponsorship Funds must be received no later than Game #4.
- 3) NO REGISTRATION FORM WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FULL PAYMENT AND ONLINE USA HOCKEY CONFIRMATION REPORT (WWW.USAHOCKEY.COM) (CLICK REGISTER ONLINE)
- 4) Teams are responsible for their own jerseys.
- 5) **If player jersey numbers are not received by Game #4, that player will not be allowed to play until jersey number is received. This policy will be strictly enforced.**

### Maximum number of players:

- 1) 18-19 Players
- 2) 1-2 Rostered goalies
- 3) 20 Rostered total
- 4) Only 18 players may dress per game

### Number of Games:

18Games – 1 Playoff Game Guaranteed per Season for the first thru fourth place teams.

### Rosters:

No players may be added after game 10.

### It is imperative that you check in at the front window prior to game time:

- Leave your name with the office staff
- You must attend a minimum of 10 games and be paid in full in order to take part in playoffs (including injuries). Goalies are excluded from this 10 game rule.

### House Rules:

1. The Zam Operator will leave the ice if a player gets on the ice before the zam doors are closed. The game will begin with an incomplete zam.
2. All suspensions are served with the same team in the same league.
3. The captain and goaltender will be given a goalie list of names and numbers. **Each team is responsible for finding a substitute goalie for their team.** If a goalie is not found, the team has the option to suit up a player as a goalie or skate six players.
4. All games will start at the game time posted on your schedule. It is imperative that every player be on time if they desire full ice time.
  - \* Every game will start with a three-minute warm-up
  - \* If one or both teams do not have 4 players and a goalie on the ice after the warm-up, the game clock will start.
5. Forfeits:  
A game will become a forfeit if a team does not have at least 4 players (four players must be on the team roster) and a goalie on the ice at the start of the game. A team with only four rostered players may borrow up to three skaters (to make 7 skaters total) from other In-House teams, **IN THE SAME DIVISION OR DIVISION BELOW**, in our league, in order to have an official game.
6. **\*\*\* No player substitutions are allowed. Rostered players only. \*\*\***
7. Game Length:  
\*Each game will consist of three stop-time periods. First and second periods will be 13 minutes in length and the third period will be half of the time remaining in the game. (curfew) If a team has a six goal lead at any time during the game, there will be run time.  
\*One time-out will be allowed per team per game. After three penalties in a single game, the player must leave the ice/game.
8. **Three game suspensions equal a hearing to determine future playing in league.**  
Abuse of On-ice or Off-ice Officials will not be tolerated. Any abuse of officials will result in an automatic hearing to predict future playing in league. Game protests due to illegal players will be considered ONLY if submitted in writing on score sheet by end of the first period by the Captain of that team.
9. **Racial slurs will not be tolerated.** Any racial slur will result in an automatic hearing to predict future playing in league.
10. Team captain must be designated prior to game time and noted on score sheet.  
This individual is the only person authorized to speak to the On-Ice or Off-Ice officials during the game.
11. Fisticuffs (Fighting) will result in a 5-game suspension.
